FUND DESCRIPTION

Laurium Capital has been appointed as the exclusive portfolio manager for our singlemanaged PPS Stable Growth Fund. Laurium Capital has an absolute return mindset and a longstanding track record in fixed interest, multi-asset high, and alternative offerings. In the PPS Stable Growth Fund (and in our other single-managed strategies) our approach is to identify a manager, through our comprehensive research process, with the skill set and capabilities to successfully manage a strategy, but who does not yet offer such a fund in the retail space.

The PPS Stable Growth Fund aims to achieve moderate returns while preserving capital over the medium to long term. The primary objective of the fund is to outperform the ASISA SA Multi Asset Medium Equity category average. The investment horizon for this fund is greater than five years.

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MANAGER COMMENTARY

The PPS Stable Growth Fund ended the quarter up strongly, outperforming the peer group by more than 1.5%. From an asset allocation perspective most of the return was delivered by equities over the quarter. The fund's domestic equity positions in Naspers/Prosus, MTN, PGM miners Impala and Anglo-American Platinum, all contributed positively to performance, whilst positions in AngloGold, Liberty Life and Ethos Capital detracted from performance.

The funds exposure to the longer dated portion of the South African government bond yield curve also detracted from performance, with the fund's positions in the 2044 and 2035 expiry instruments impacting the most by the pickup in yields in Q1 2021.

Our positions in the miners - Anglo Platinum, Anglo American, Northam Platinum, Impala Platinum and BHP - Naspers, Sasol and MTN contributed positively to performance, whilst positions in Anglogold and financials stocks - Liberty, Standard Bank, Firstrand and Absa - detracted from performance. For PPS Stable Growth that has an offshore allocation, we had positive performance from our offshore portion of the portfolio. Our fixed income positioning detracted marginally from performance.
